Dear Sir:

Pursuant to SEC Memorandum Circular No. 5, Series of 2020 and SEC Notice dated 18 March 2020, we request that the due date for the filing of the Corporation's Annual Report (SEC 17A) and its Consolidated Financial Statements for the Year Ending December 31, 2019, be extended to June 30, 2020 without penalty.

Such request for extension is primarily because the whole of Luzon was placed under an Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) by the Philippine Government. In addition, several local government units imposed lockdowns in their respective jurisdictions in the Philippines. Accordingly, the Corporation, in line with original safeguarding mechanism and its commitment to the employees that the employees be free from any health hazards or risks, implemented a work-from-home policy to prevent their officers, staff and employees from getting infected with or exposed to the virus. In effect, the Corporation's employees who are responsible in the preparations and filing of the report (together with our external auditors) are mostly confined in their homes and observing the work-from-home status. This has caused difficulties in the coordination and in the preparation of the reports.

Rest assured, the Corporation continuously observes its obligations in under the Securities Regulation Code and the Revised Disclosure Rules of the Philippine Stock Exchange. The Corporation further ensures that all material information, whether price-sensitive or trade sensitive, will be disclosed on a timely basis, and where the Corporation's operations are materially affected by the COVID-19 outbreak, disclosure on the financial impact or any other material aspects will be made immediately.

Lastly, we intend to hold the Corporation's annual stockholders meeting on the month of December, subject to the approval of the Corporation's board of directors. We will file the necessary disclosures, once the board approves the date of the annual stockholders' meeting.

Your further assistance on the matter is much appreciated.
