**Proposed Reclamation Project of the Issuer with the Province of Cavite**

On July 11, 2018, the Issuer's wholly owned subsidiary, Century Peak Corporation ("CPC"), represented by its President, Mr. Wilfredo D. Keng, and the Province of Cavite, represented by its Governor, Atty. Jesus Crispin C. Remulla, issued a Joint Certification stating that CPC and the Province of Cavite "have successfully concluded the detailed negotiations between [them] on the unsolicited proposal submitted by [CPC] for the reclamation of one thousand three hundred thirty-three (1,332)(sic) hectares of land within the territorial jurisdiction of the [Province of Cavite] and have come to an agreement regarding the terms and conditions of the said project."

A copy of the Joint Certification is attached as Annex A.

The Joint Certification further states that the terms and conditions of CPC's unsolicited proposal shall be subject to a competitive challenge, pursuant to the Cavite Provincial Ordinance No. 002-5-2012. Thus, an agreement between CPC and the Province of Cavite will be executed only if the project is awarded to CPC following a competitive challenge.



## JOINT CERTIFICATION

We hereby certify that we have successfully concluded the detailed negotiations between the Provincial Government of Cavite and Century Peak Corporation on the unsolicited proposal submitted by the latter for the reclamation of one thousand three hundred thirty-three (1,332) hectares of land within the territorial jurisdiction of the former and have come to an agreement regarding the terms and conditions of the said project.

The full feasibility study and other documents submitted by Century Peak Corporation shall necessary form part of the agreement, except those provisions, undertakings, and commitments that have been modified during the detailed negotiations, including, among other things, the following:


1. *Land Sharing.* For and in consideration of its capital and risks, the private sector proponent shall be entitled to ninety percent (90%) of the total net usable land area. The Government, including the Province, shall be entitled to ten percent (10%) of the net usable land area, in addition to the government's share. The Province shall be exclusively entitled to such area as may be necessary and as identified for the construction of a coastal highway to be taken from the area designated for roads and open spaces.


2. *Construction and completion period.* Within the period of six years from the time the permits and clearances have been issued by all concerned government agencies, the private sector proponent undertakes to complete at least eighty percent (80%) of the total project consisting of five islands, with the area intended for the coastal highway as fully completed. For this purpose, the Province shall extend its fullest cooperation and assistance in securing the necessary permits and clearances, especially on fill materials to be extracted from the San Nicolas Shoal and such areas as may be identified.

3. *No cost to the government.* Given the nature and spirit of Public-Private-Partnership projects, the Provincial Government of Cavite shall assume no cost and risk for the project.

We further certify that the terms and conditions for the unsolicited proposal as agreed upon shall be subjected to a competitive challenge, pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 002-S-2012.
